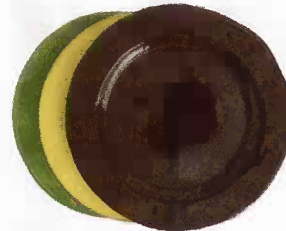
Vase
